Where we keep your data

The data processor for the APPG is provided by CHWA. Only staff who work at this organisation have access to this database.

What we do with your data

We use your data to:

- Analyse the attendance of the APPG's meetings.
- Contact you if there is information concerning the APPG, ie updates on annual reports, minutes and actions from previous meetings and send invites for APPG events.

Who your data will be shared with

Your details will never be shared with any third parties, and only CHWA staff in charge of the APPG will have access to your data

How long we will keep you data

We will keep the data you register with us for 10 years, unless before then:

- You request your data records to be completely removed from our database
- The APPG comes to a close
